



GENERAL INFORMATION ALL ENTRIES

- 1. PREMIUM LISTS: THE GENERAL MAILING OF THE WESTMINSTER PREMIUM LIST WILL ONLY BE DONE ELECTRONICALLY. They will also be available on both the westminsterkennelclub.org and infodog.com websites. A limited number of premium lists will be available at shows handled by MB-F.
- 2. **ENTRY FORMS:** The Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show entry forms are prepared with club-specific and unique rules and requirements as well as being in accordance with the American Kennel Club's Rules Applying to Dog Shows. All information required on the entry form is used to insure the accuracy of all entries. Each entry and all the information it contains is verified as part of the entry's acceptance. This method maintains the integrity of the process and fairness to all exhibitors who enter the show. All rules and regulations for entry into the show are noted in the premium list. It's ultimately the responsibility of the Exhibitor to correctly complete and return the entry form and contact MB-F with any questions. The Superintendent uniformly follows and enforces all rules in receiving and processing the entries. AKC will audit all entries to validate AKC Championship, status and/or proper AKC Registration.
- 3. ALL ENTRIES MUST be submitted by an actual owner or the duly authorized agent* of the owner(s) (the person responsible for the dog at the show) or through an established legal entry service (whose normal business is the taking and submitting of dog show entries), or through our superintendent's entry service infodog.com. ALL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED starting March 19, 2021, or immediately after the Top 5 AKC Champions, AKC Champion National Specialty, Obedience and Qualifying Junior Invitees lists are posted, whichever is earliest. Entries Received before this date will be returned. If an exhibitor utilizes an entry service or infodog. com to submit an entry for our show, the time of submission of the entry has no bearing on when, or if, the entry is accepted into the show. InfoDog online entries will be printed and placed in the postal bin with a check just as all other entries for our show.

*For the purposes of this show, any reference to an owner's "duly authorized agent" anywhere in The Westminster Kennel Club premium list, catalog, news releases, promotions, etc., refers ONLY to that person who is responsible for the dog at the show and who will be exhibiting the dog in the ring.

- 4. THERE IS A LIMIT OF ONE ENTRY FORM PER ENVELOPE. (DO <u>NOT</u> SEND MULTIPLE INDIVIDUAL ENVELOPES IN THE MAILING ENVELOPE. <u>ALL</u> OF THEM WILL BE RETURNED WITH NO RECOURSE.)
- 5. All entries must be accompanied by a check or money order payable in U.S. Funds.
 - a.) When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check.
 - b.) Checks or money orders returned by the financial institution for ANY reason will cause the entry to be removed from the show with no recourse.
 - c.) Credit Cards will NOT be accepted for mailed-in entries.
- 6. ALL ENTRIES MAY BE SUBMITTED via any traditional postal service that will deliver to a P.O. Box and does not require a signature for delivery OR through infodog.com at anytime within noted dates/times to be received no later than 3:00 P.M. (E.S.T.) Friday, April 9, 2021.

a.) All mailed Conformation/Junior/Obedience entries must be sent to: P.O. Box 22067, Greensboro, NC 27420 ONLY. This box accepts Westminster entries ONLY.

b.) DO NOT SUBMIT entries for other shows to this box AT ANYTIME AND DO NOT send entries for other shows in the Westminster return envelope - you run the risk of not being entered in that other show.

7. MAIL OPTIONS - INCLUDING FOREIGN

When making your entries to MB-F, please be sure to follow the instructions of one entry per envelope and note:

- It is important that you make your entry online OR use the regular US Postal Service to mail your entry, time permitting, MB-F will not accept any mailers requiring a signature but instead, will return them to the sender.
- For the return documentation including your ID/Ticket Packet, since mailing the packet to you may not work out due to time constraints, you have the option of having your Westminster packet held at the Superintendent's Office at the show. It would be available for pick up in the Superintendent's Office beginning Friday, June 11, 2021 through Sunday, June 13, 2021 during the published hours.
 - To take advantage of this option, clearly checkmark the box at the bottom
 of the front page of the Westminster entry form or in the pop-up window
 during the online conformation entry process (be sure you have enabled
 pop-ups for this show). Also be sure your email address is noted clearly
 and correctly.
 - You will receive an email noting you have requested this option.
 - You should bring this email with you to the show. The note is not an admittance ticket; but it permits you to go to the Superintendent's Office to get your admission packet.

8. FOREIGN VETERINARY STAMPING

If this is a necessary item for you, and you are from a country where USDA stamping is required, it is strongly recommended these arrangements be made before leaving your home. If you require special provisions the following group can assist you.

Appointments are necessary. A medical fee is charged for this service.

IMPORTANT: Please note that if you do not bring the necessary International Health Certificate with you before leaving home, it may delay your return, as due to COVID regulations at this time, two-week quarantine may be required before being seen by a veterinarian to obtain the necessary documents.

- 9. **DO NOT BRING UNENTERED DOGS:** There is NO space for unentered dogs.
- 10. VENUES: Breed judging and Junior Showmanship preliminaries will take place on the specified days of the show. Obedience judging will be on Saturday ONLY. Group and Best in Show judging will take place on Saturday and Sunday evenings and Junior Showmanship Finals will be on Sunday evening.
- 11. **LYNDHURST:** Exhibitors must use the designated entrance to Lyndhurst. The loading/unloading and admittance procedures, along with vehicle staging and arrival times and other pertinent information, will be included in the Exhibitor Ticket Packet.
- 12. **PLEASE NOTE:** Best in Show, All Variety Groups, Obedience and Junior Showmanship Finals will be judged on turf in a tented arena.

13. PARKING:

- 14. **NOTICE:** The use of any Westminster Kennel Club logo trademark or any other likeness associated with The Westminster Kennel Club is expressly prohibited without the written consent of the club.
- 15. ATTENTION Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs: If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf. Most important to note are the following:
 - Dogs must be eligible for the individual class in which it is entered.
 - Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf. If you have question or need assistance with registration or obtaining an extension, please contact the AKC Special Services Department at: awards@akc.org or (919) 233-9767 (followed by selecting option 4).
- 14. **NOTE:** All conformation dogs must be AKC Champions and all obedience dogs must have AKC OTCH status, at the time entries are submitted.

RAMPS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotti Romagnoli, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeens, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc.). At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on a table or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Mudik (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels, Whippets & Miniature Bull Terriers.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.



JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP FINALISTS SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Westminster Kennel Club will award the following scholarships to eight Junior Showmanship Finalists at the show for their use in post-secondary schooling for the college or technical school of their choice.

For dogs attempting to enter both Juniors and the Breed/Obedience competition, acceptance into the Junior Showmanship class at this show does NOT guarantee acceptance into the Breed/Obedience competition.

Entries for dogs entered in breed/obedience competition and in Junior Showmanship competition are subject to all the provisions outlined in this premium list and on the entry form as to fee, closing date, eligibility, benching, etc. DUE TO THE LARGE ENTRY, A JUNIOR MAY BE JUDGED ON A DAY DIFFERENT FROM THE DAY THEIR BREED IS SHOWN. SEE ALSO PAGES 4, 11-13, 25-38.

Entries for dogs entered in Junior Showmanship may not be postmarked any time prior to the list of qualifying Juniors being posted at westminsterkennelclub.org and/or infodog.com or March 19, 2021, whichever is the earliest date. Please follow the instructions on the reverse of the entry form. However, all forms must be completed and received by MB-F, Inc., P.O. Box 22067, Greensboro, NC 27420, no later than 3:00 P.M. E.S.T., Friday, April 9, 2021. IT IS THE JUNIOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE YOUR ENTRY IS CORRECTLY SUBMITTED AND RECEIVED BY THE CLOSING. JUNIOR ENTRIES ARRIVING AFTER THE CLOSING DATE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED THAT REQUIRES A SIGNATURE FOR DELIVERY.

IMPORTANT NOTE: IF A JUNIOR IS SHOWING A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN THE BEST OF BREED/VARIETY OR OBEDIENCE CLASSES DO NOT SEND SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS. Dogs entered as a Junior Only may NOT add one of the offered Breed or Obedience classes at a later time, nor can another entry for the same dog be submitted for the offered Breed or Obedience classes competition at a later time. Dogs entered in this manner may not be transferred to the offered Breed or Obedience classes. Juniors are not part of the entry limit. - **NON-INVITED:** Dogs eligible for AKC Obedience Trial Open B and Utility B Classes that have earned the AKC Obedience Trial Championship (OTCH) prior to submitting their entry for this event are also eligible but will not receive an advanced invitation. (See page 29.)

ENTRIES LIMITED: Entries are limited to the first-received 25 Obedience dogs that meet the noted requirements. Submit one entry per envelope ONLY.

ENTRIES CLOSE at 3:00 P.M. (E.S.T.), Friday, April 9, 2021 or when the maximum number of 25 invited Obedience dogs has been reached, if reached before 3:00 P.M. (E.S.T.), April 9, 2021.

The Rules, Regulations and Policies in accordance with the American Kennel Club and The Westminster Kennel Club will be followed unless stated otherwise.

The 2021 Westminster Masters Obedience Championship will be awarded to the dog earning the Highest Combined Qualifying Score from the two competing classes.

- The Streicher Cup, an Antique Trophy, is offered by David W. Haddock to the High in Trial from either of the two competing classes, in memory of Judson L. Streicher. For permanent possession to be won three times by the same ownership.

- A Bronze Medallion to the 2nd through 4th placements for Highest Qualifying Combined.

Rosettes will be given for 1st (Blue), 2nd (Red), 3rd (Yellow) and 4th (White) placements in each obedience class.

NOTE: The dog winning The Masters Obedience Championship will be requested to appear at the Group Ring Saturday evening, June 12, 2021 for a Trophy Presentation.

- 1. **INVITED DOGS:** The Top 200 ranked Obedience dogs based on OTCH points earned will be invited to enter, including those dogs that may be listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, and any handler and dog team that together have won the previous year's Masters or AKC National Obedience Championship. The Top 200 will be determined by the AKC ranking of those dogs receiving the most OTCH points only at AKC Obedience Trials held from November 1, 2019 through February 15, 2021 inclusive. In the case of a tie all qualifying dogs are invited. A listing of the Invitees will be posted on **westminsterkennelclub.org** and **infodog.com** as soon as final stats are received from AKC and processed. <u>You do NOT need to wait to receive the Invitation in order to submit your entry.</u>
- 2. **Non-Invited Dogs:** Dogs eligible for AKC Obedience Trial Open B and Utility B Classes, including those dogs that maybe listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, that have attained their OTCH status prior to submitting their entry may also submit an entry.

- 3. Entries for an invited or non-invited Obedience dog may be sent as soon as the list is posted or beginning March 19, 2021, whichever is earliest. Entries sent prior to that time will be returned. NOTE: A Memento Certificate acknowledging the Top 200 status qualifying the dog's eligibility to be invited to pre-enter, along with a pre-printed entry form and addressed return envelope, will be sent in mid-March via regular First Class Mail to the owner at the address on file with MB-F, Inc. Please follow the instructions on the reverse of the pre-printed entry form. Please include the jump height. No entry will be accepted that requires a signature for delivery.
- 4. **ADDRESS CHANGES** for the Qualifying Certificate must be reported to the Superintendent prior to 5:00 P.M. (E.S.T.) March 1, 2021. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to verify the address on file with the Superintendent.
- 5. OBEDIENCE ENTRIES MAY BE SUBMITTED TO: P.O. Box 22067, Greensboro, NC 27420 via any traditional postal service that will deliver to a P.O. Box and does not require a signature for delivery or through infodog.com at anytime within noted dates/times to be received no later than 3:00 P.M., Friday, April 9, 2021. Fax, Dial-N-Entry, courier, walkins, or entries handed in at shows are NOT acceptable or permitted. Entries must be received no later than 3:00 P.M. (E.S.T.), Friday, April 9, 2021. ENTRIES SUBMITTED TO ANY OTHER ADDRESS MAY RESULT IN DELIVERY DELAYS AND THE POSSIBLE RETURN OF THE ENTRY WITHOUT RECOURSE.
- 6. DUPLICATE ENTRIES: See page 32 for details.
- 7. ALL ENTRIES MUST be submitted by an actual owner or the duly authorized agent* of the owner(s) (the person responsible for the dog at the show) or through an established legal entry service (whose normal business is the taking and submitting of dog show entries). If an exhibitor utilizes an entry service to submit an entry for our show, the time of submission of the entry has no bearing on when, or if, the entry is accepted into the show. THERE IS A LIMIT OF ONE ENTRY FORM PER ENVELOPE. All entries must be accompanied by a check or money order payable in U.S. Funds. When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check. Credit Cards will NOT be acceptable. Checks or money orders returned for ANY reason will cause the entry to be removed from the show without recourse.

Please read the Rules and Requirements for ALL entrants on Pages 11-13, 23-38 of this Premium List. Consult westminsterkennelclub.org for complete information on Obedience, Finals Performance, Required Elements and Elective Element Guidelines details.

*For the purposes of this show, any reference to an owner's "duly authorized agent" anywhere in The Westminster Kennel Club premium list, catalog, news releases, promotions, etc., refers ONLY to that person who is responsible for the dog at the show and who will be exhibiting the dog in the ring.

- 8. Obedience will be conducted on turf in main Group Ring.
- 9. EXERCISES: The Westminster Kennel Club Masters Obedience Championship competition will consist of the regular AKC Open B and Utility B classes. A single entry fee (\$80.00) will provide for competition in both classes. Qualifying scores and points will be recorded on the dog's AKC record.
 - The Open B and Utility B classes will be performed and judged according to the AKC Obedience Regulations.
 - The judge will post the order of exercises for each class approximately 45 minutes prior to the start of judging. All dogs will complete exercises in the posted order.
 - The dogs will be judged in jump height order, low to high.
 - The competition ring will be 40' x 50' and will be on turf.
 - The equipment will be standard AKC regulation jumps, but may not necessarily be a standard AKC color.
 - A lunch break will be taken at the discretion of the judge.
 - In the event a run-off for a placement is required, the judge will decide the run-off pattern, and the exercise to be performed.
 - Official scores from both classes will be posted at the end of the event.
 - The Highest Combined Qualifying Score from both classes will determine the 2021 Westminster Masters Obedience Champion.
- 10. **TICKETS:** Regardless of ownership of the dog(s) one exhibitor's gate admission for all days is sent for each dog entered. The gate admission is needed for admission into the show. The person accompanying the dog must show an admission ticket and the dog identification before the dog will be admitted. **DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED.** See pages 7, 39 for additional ticket information.
- 11. **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not eligible to participate in Obedience. Refund of entry fee for bitches entered in Obedience that come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by providing written verification from a veterinarian to the superintendent which must be RECEIVED by the superintendent PRIOR to the opening hour of the show. A copy of the Veterinarian's certification AND a copy of the final confirmation of the dog's entry MUST accompany any such request for a refund.

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL ENTRIES

- THERE IS A LIMIT OF ONE ENTRY FORM PER ENVELOPE. Note: If 1. a dog you are entering in the Best of Breed/Variety class or the Masters Obedience Championship will also be in Junior Showmanship it should be so noted on the SAME form and will count as one entry form. If, however, you are entering a dog in one of the offered Breed or Obedience classes and a different dog in Junior Showmanship Only they will need to be sent in separate envelopes. ANY INDIVIDUAL ENVELOPE CONTAINING MORE THAN ONE ENTRY FORM OR MULTIPLE ENVELOPES WILL DISOUALIFY ALL ENTRIES RECEIVED IN THAT ENVELOPE/PACKAGE AND THE ENTIRE CONTENTS WILL BE RETURNED WITH NO RECOURSE TO THE INDIVIDUAL OR AGENT WHO SUBMITTED THE ENTRIES, NOR THOSE WHOSE ENTRIES ARE RETURNED DUE TO A VIOLATION OF THIS CLUB RULE. Do NOT send separate entry form for a Junior who is showing a dog entered also in one of the offered Breed or Obedience classes. If a dog is entered in breed and Juniors or Obedience and Juniors, and the limit is reached the valid Junior portion of the entry is still acceptable.
- 2. The Top Five AKC Champion dogs in each breed, Qualifying AKC Champion National Breed Specialty Best of Breed winners, Top 200 Obedience dogs based on most OTCH points ranking and Qualifying Juniors will be posted on both **westminsterkennelclub.org** and **infodog.com** once final statistics are received from the AKC and processed. You have until 5:00 P.M. (E.S.T.), March 1, 2021 to provide MB-F with any address changes to your data file. In the case of a tie, all qualifying dogs or Juniors are invited. Any exhibitor who believes their dog or Junior Handler meets these requirements and does not appear on the posted list should call MB-F at (336) 379-9352 before 5:00 P.M. (E.S.T.), March 16, 2021 for further instructions.
- 3. **DUPLICATE ENTRIES:** Duplicate entries and fees received into processing PRIOR to the closing of entries, or prior to the limit being reached if reached prior to the closing date and time, WILL NOT BE RETURNED. A portion of these proceeds will be donated to The Westminster Kennel Club Junior Scholarship Awards. Entries and fees received into processing AFTER the close of entries, or after the limit is reached if reached prior to the closing date and time, will be returned.
- 4. ENTRY FORMS: You may use any Official AKC Breed/Obedience entry form or photocopy of that form to enter this show. IN ALL CASES YOU MUST SUBMIT BOTH SIDES OF THE ENTRY FORM. If using an entry form other than the one provided in this premium list you must clearly indicate the Westminster Kennel Club name and complete date at the top of the

first page. NOTE: Breed and Obedience Dogs MUST have attained their required AKC Title status BEFORE entry is submitted. Entries submitted for Obedience Dogs must include the jump height. Entries received without required information cannot be accepted. Entry forms received without the back page of the entry form are not valid and cannot be accepted.

NOTE: MB-F accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry form instructions and Rules Applying to Dog Shows (rules) of the American Kennel Club. From time to time these are subject to change. In the event of a discrepancy in these entry form instructions, Agreement and rules versus the text within the entry form you sign and submit, the AKC Agreement, entry form instructions and rules in effect at the time these entries close will take precedence.

- 5. **NOTE:** Entrants should be aware that pieces sent via postal service "Delivery Confirmation" are scanned at the time they come off the truck NOT at the time they are delivered to the P.O. Box. The scanned time indicates only that it arrived at the facility.
- 6. "Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." This would include up-to-date rabies shot.
- 7. Please review your entry form prior to submitting. Be sure it matches your AKC Registration. Submitting incorrect information could hold up the processing of your entry. It could further result in the disallowance of a win or in not permitting the dog to be shown. The printed show catalog is distributed world-wide and incorrect information submitted would be reprinted by the press or portrayed in other media. Owners are responsible for such errors no matter who submits the information. Once entries are closed, AKC DOES NOT ALLOW any correction to the entry information other than a correction to the sex of the dog.
- 8. Once entries close and the preliminary audit is completed all entries that include a valid e-mail address on their entry form will be sent an e-mail notice of receipt of entry pending AKC validation of their championship and/or proper registration (approximately 10 business days after closing). A hardcopy notice of receipt of entry will also be mailed First Class via the U.S. Postal Service. There will be no entry confirmation over the telephone. Any inquiries must be in writing giving dog's breed, name, AKC# and whether dog is invited, non-invited, Junior Showmanship or Obedience entry and the class in which the dog is entered. Inquiries by postal mail or e-mail (mbf2@infodog.com) only. NOTE: This e-mail address is used exclusively for Westminster information ONLY. Do not send messages regarding other shows to this e-mail address.

- 9. After the closing time no entries will be accepted, cancelled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed (exception AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6 or Junior Regulations Section 7) and no entry fee refunded (except as provided in AKC Obedience Rules Chapter 1 Section 14). Telephoned or telegraphed entries, conditional entries, and/ or photocopied entries without the AKC agreement on the back are not acceptable. All changes, completions, cancellations MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING before closing. Cancellations or Changes must include the show, dog's registration number, breed, name and a signature.
- 10. This Club and/or its superintendents assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner, or a legal entry service engaged by the owner, nor for the owner or the owner's agent or legal entry service entering a dog in a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete, nor for entering the same dog twice, nor for entering the wrong dog.
- 11. Fees payable in U.S. Funds must accompany entries. Unsigned checks, Returned and Post-Dated checks/money orders do not constitute an entry fee. Any entry that has an unsigned check or a returned or post dated check/money order will be returned. No dogs will be added to replace these entries.
 - CHARGEBACKS on Credit Cards are considered a violation of your agreement to pay the required entry fee for entry into a show. If this remains a bad debt, the club may decline future entries for their shows and the superintendent will decline future entries for ANY show submitted via any method of payment until the debt is paid (Chap 11, Sec 15, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Thereafter, the superintendent will refuse all future credit card entries from the exhibitor. All future entries must be paid for in cash or by money order or check.
- 12. Entry fees are NOT refunded when a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for bitches in season entered in Conformation or Junior Showmanship or for duplicate entries. See also pages 24, 32-38.
- 13. The Club may decline any entries for cause. In addition, they may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- 14. No entry fees are returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, wars, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions, fire and Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, and the dictates of law

enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or any other cause beyond the control of The Westminster Kennel Club, nor shall Lyndhurst or the Superintendent be liable in any way. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

EXHIBITOR TICKET INFORMATION

NOTICE: Without Madison Square Garden, Groups and Best in Show seating will be VERY limited. We hope that exhibitors, who remain on site, will be able to view the finals from monitors in an auxiliary tent if New York State guidelines and restrictions allow.

- 1. **Regardless** of the ownership of the dog(s) one exhibitor's gate admission for each day is sent for each dog entered and is needed for admittance. The person accompanying the dog must show an admission ticket and the dog identification before the dog will be admitted. **DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED.** There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show. **See also pages 2, 9, 27, 31, 38.**
- 2. All regular exhibitor tickets, dog ID's, etc., are sent to the address noted on the entry form. Owners or the owners' duly authorized agent are responsible for the correctness. **No duplicate packets are mailed.** See page 12 regarding the Foreign Mail Option.
- 3. Regular exhibitor ticket packets returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" are held at the show in the Superintendent's Office.

TROPHIES

Trophies and prizes are awarded in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who is considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before completion of the judging of the Breed, Juniors or Obedience classes and the Superintendent's office advised at once of any discrepancy. The Superintendent and the show-giving Club disclaim any liability for prizes or trophies after the judging of that Breed, Juniors or Obedience is over.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

1. The WKC, the Superintendent and site management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or property of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the time the dog is on the show premises. See also the Agreement on the reverse of the entry form.

- 2. The welfare of an exhibitor's/spectator's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor/spectator. It is expressly understood that exhibitors/spectators will exercise control and restraint over their children while they are on the show premises. The use of child strollers is NOT recommended.
- 3. The Westminster Kennel Club and its Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

EQUIPMENT

- 1. By entering this show, exhibitors and handlers agree to follow all directions of the special assistants charged with arranging and maintaining orderly conditions in the grooming areas. Abuse of these assistants will not be tolerated.
- 2. Grooming will take place at the exhibitor's vehicle or at the grooming tent. All crates/tack units must be stacked. Exhibitors are expected to keep their grooming area clean. Exhibitors who set up in the grooming tent should remove their equipment promptly after exhibiting unless dog is required for Group judging.
- 3. Grey water tanks will be available on site for dirty water disposal.
- 4. No Flexi/retractable leads or stacking trainer equipment permitted at this show.
- 5. Fabric crates are not permitted at this show.
- 6. Public exercise pens will be for multiple dogs at all times. Dogs must be on lead in exercise pens. No exceptions. A separate area will be provided for bitches in season. Owners/handlers are to clean-up after their dogs. Blocking off exercise pens is NOT permitted.
- 7. For the safety of all, no other tables and other furniture are allowed in the ring areas. No aisle obstruction is permitted.
- 8. Handbills, circulars, or other printed matter may not be distributed at this show.

- 9. No gasoline or diesel powered generators are permitted within 100 feet of any tent in which the show is conducted. All cords must be secured to avoid tripping hazards.

- 4. The Westminster Kennel Club reserves the right to broadcast or cause to be broadcast any or all portions of The Westminster Kennel Club Dog show by any means of known transmission of video material.
- 5. The use of any Westminster Kennel Club logo, trademark or any other likeness associated with the Westminster Kennel Club is expressly prohibited without the written consent of the club.


